Take it once – Credit Twice!

Advantages for Student

- Encourage students to take technical courses
- Some students last chance to gain workplace competencies
- Encourage students to continue their training

Advantages for Instructor!

- Networking with post secondary instructors
- Opportunities at the community college
 - Additional training in Distance Education
 - Ability to use online classroom for high school classroom
 - Software cost reductions for home use and/or grant opportunities for software/equipment

Cost?

- Three Plans
 - Use the secondary teacher – no tuition cost to the student
 - Use the post-secondary instructor – tuition to the student paid by school or student
 - Use the secondary teacher with a paid stipend – some tuition paid by school or student

How do I get started?

- Contact the community college in your district
 - Instructor in Office Technology or Applied Business program
 - Technical Dual Credit Director
- Memorandum of Understanding
 - Between the college and secondary school
 - 4 year plan (2 years of high school and 2 years of community college)

Rules for TDC

- Must transfer at least 6 hours into a technical degree
- Must have a 6-year plan
- Courses must match WECM SLOs
- Courses must be comparable in rigor
 - High school course can cover more but must cover SLOs at a minimum
 - Use Master Course Syllabi at the college level as guide
