
Veterinary Assisting, Dental Assisting and Biotechnology

All events that currently use either an official HOSA portfolio or an official HOSA notebook now have the option to use either one. The choice is up to the competitor.






General Updates

General Rules & Regulations

Rule #30 changed to state that skill events usually include 1-3 skills from the event guidelines.





All of the event guidelines have been updated to add the header "Event Guidelines". This is done in an attempt to assure that HOSA members understand the rules of each event. At NLC, competitors are required to bring their copy of the event guidelines to their specific event orientation
